## COMMUNITY ADVENT CELEBRATION GOALS:

- Honoring God by:
  - Sharing the Good News
  - Loving our neighbors through community advent events
    - Showing them what Jesus looks like
    - Special emphasis on children
  - Charitable Outreach:
    - Encourage special giving (over and above tithing) or through fundraising to purchase food gift cards
      - Distribute food gift cards to Wednesday Community Dinner guests each week in Advent
    - Extravagant hospitality and giving . . . all events, activities and meals at no charge

# TRIAD

Church is unknown for a lot of people. Using Triad events allows them to meet people and build trust.

- **Splash Event**

- Low Jesus

- **Second Event**

- Midsize
- A bit more Jesus

- **Third Event**

- Smaller
- Invite them to Christmas
- Offer a couple of different studies to invite them to
  - This is where we do deeper formation and relationship building

## EXTERIOR STATIC ADVENT INSTALLATIONS

- To be installed prior to events and will remain all during Advent
- Large Advent Candles Display in yard lit each week and Christmas Eve
- “Bethlehem Star” in tall tree for optimum viewing
- Church Families to “Sponsor” and light a tree(s)
- Vendor donated commercial lights in trees

- Petting Zoo - Atrium
- Wise Men giving gifts - Sanctuary Steps
- Front parking lot activities:

    - Drive-thru w/music
  - Petting Zoo - Atrium
- Enter building through south entrance
- Wise Men giving children gifts - Main Hallway
- Angel Gift Shop, Crafts and Games in the Grove
- Soup Sanctuary in Whitehurst Hall plus dessert Bar
- Ongoing Dramas/Interaction in Whitehurst Hall telling the story of Jesus' birth.
- Cookie Gift Boxes parting gifts to each family



## WHERE DO WE GO FROM HERE?

- Develop a Plan of Action with Milestones (POAM)
  - Shows details for each task, responsible group, POC, start and completion dates
- Start advertising campaign to encourage church members to schedule their holiday calendars and plan designated Advent giving (***emphasising above and beyond their tithe***) focused on these events.
- Reach out to other groups to participate (OG School, local Methodist churches, Scouts, other church affiliated groups)
- Contact local vendors, businesses, restaurants, etc. for donations and sponsorships
- Design “Follow the Star” signature t-shirts
- Volunteers to purchase their own shirt to be worn during events
- Put sponsoring vendor information on back of t-shirt
- Discuss with each ministry, Sunday School, Small Group, etc. how they choose to sponsor each separate activity to avoid fatigue or duplication
